Did you know that a pedestrian is killed every seven minutes in the U.S? It has been brought to Management's attention that it is difficult to see the crosswalk on the left hand side when exiting the community. Management will be trimming the foliage that is inhibiting visibility. Please do your part to slow down, double look, and do not block crosswalks.



<u>Parking</u> Reminders

With the upcoming holidays, many homeowners will have visitors. Please review the following parking rules, and <u>also, remember to always</u> inform all guests of the rules.

- Garages must be utilized for parking two vehicles.
- Parking boats, trailers, and motor homes are prohibited on all streets.



- Guests must park in designated guest spaces and at raised curbs.
- Always allow a twenty-foot driving lane between parked vehicles when parking.
- Blocking any driveway, garage, or sidewalk is in direct violation of the City ordinance.
- Red curbs are Fire Lanes, blocking them can result in towing and fines from the City.
- Parking facing the wrong way is against the law and prohibited.

Please be aware that some of these rules are laws of the City of San Diego, and violating them may result in action from the City of San Diego.

Violating any of the above parking rules may result in a violation or hearing notice, and your car can be towed. If you are called to a hearing, you may be fined.

♦ Keep matches and lighters out of kids' reach.




The number of deaths, caused by children playing with fire, goes up significantly during the holidays.

- Test smoke alarms once a month by pushing the test button.
- Don't leave a frying pan unattended with the stove on. Frying is the riskiest kind of cooking because the oil provides ready fuel.
- Don't throw water on a grease fire. Water is heavier than oil so it plunges to the bottom and sends the grease flying up in a lethal fireball.

Exterior December holiday lighting may be installed no earlier than the day after Thanksgiving, and must be removed by the end of the following month, January 15th. If these rules are not followed, you may receive a violation letter or be called to a hearing where you may be fined.



Party Noise
