CHIMNEY SAFETY

With colder weather coming upon us, please remember these fireplace safety tips:

- Keep flammable objects at least 2 feet away from the fireplace.
- Always supervise the fire and never leave it burning when going to sleep or leaving the home.



In addition, keep in mind, it is almost that time of year to employ a chimney sweep to inspect and clean your fireplace and chimney. Please note that the spark arrestor on your chimney is your responsibility to maintain and should be thoroughly inspected. If damage to your spark arrestor is noted, it should be replaced. If a damaged spark arrestor is not replaced, it could cause a safety issue when the fireplace is in use.

IMPORTANT PARKING REMINDERS

Please review the following parking rules and remember to always inform all guests of the rules.

- Garages must be utilized for parking two vehicles.
- Parking boats, trailers, and motor homes are prohibited on all streets.
- PARKING AREA
- Guests must park in designated guest spaces and at raised curbs.
- Always allow a twenty-foot driving lane between parked vehicles when parking.
- Blocking any driveway, garage, or sidewalk is in direct violation of the City ordinance.
- Red curbs are Fire Lanes, blocking them can result in towing and fines from the City.
- Parking facing the wrong way is against the law and prohibited.
