Trash Collection

Residents shall not put trash containers at the curb before 4:00 PM the day before the scheduled pick-up. Residents shall collect their empty trash containers the same day as the scheduled trash pick-up. Disposal of cardboard boxes and large objects is the Resident's responsibility and must conform to City collection Requirements.

There is no collection of City of San Diego trash, recyclables, or yard waste on the following 2020 City-observed holidays:

- New Year's Day, Jan. 1
- Memorial Day, May 27
- Independence Day, July 4
- Labor Day, Sept. 2
- Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 28
- Christmas Day, Dec. 25



Starting on the day of the holiday, trash is collected one day later for the remainder of that week.
